

## Governor Vacancies – Nuneaton, Warwickshire

[King Edward VI College](#) (KE6) is a sixth form college that wants to do things differently. We are proud of our 550+ year history of educating the young people of Nuneaton, but are much more focussed on our future. We were the founding college for Better Futures Multi Academy Trust (BFMAT) sponsored by Coventry University and continue to explore new ways of working that will help us reach our ambition; to develop confident, curious, happy students ready to change the world for the better. Our people, whether students, staff, governors, parents or community links, are the people that will ensure we achieve that ambition, and we are now recruiting Community Governors to fill vacancies on our Local Governing Body.

We are seeking applicants who live and/or work within travelling distance of the college, from a range of backgrounds and life experiences. The skills, knowledge and expertise we are particularly looking for at the moment include: *accounting and financial audit, people development and employment law, local communities, curriculum development and student co-creation and environmental sustainability*. However, we are interested in hearing from everybody who is interested in helping take us forward as a college.

You don't need previous experience as a governor or trustee so long as you have time and enthusiasm to participate in Governor meetings and annual strategy planning and help ensure the best possible provision for KE6 students and staff. Information and training opportunities will be available to you.

The LGB meets approximately six times per academic year, normally on a Tuesday evening from 5pm-7pm. There are some additional meetings on different days, but there is always lots of notice. Governors also have the opportunity to help shape the wider Trust direction and approaches through membership of cross trust committees such as Finance, Audit, or Student Development.

This is a voluntary role although reasonable travel expenses may be reimbursed. Appointment is subject to an enhanced DBS check.
